## Whites, Rosé and Sparkling Wines

- 166**      **Galeria Branco 2011 Aliança Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £6.00  
The Butcher's Arms dry house white - Crisp dry white with mouth filling apple and citrus fruit scented with a peppery spice. A delightfully creamy and delicate white wine.
- 166r**      **Vista TR Rosé 2010/11 Aliança Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £6.00  
A classic light rosé wine, medium bodied with berry flavours and a lovely clean finish. An easy drinking rosé. Perfect for the garden.
- 14**      **Aliança Rosé (Medium Dry) Sparkling Rosé Methode Champenoise** ..... £9.00  
Raspberry and Cassis flavours and a light pink colour, this medium dry fizz is always a special tippie for the ladies.
- 61**      **Casas Novas Vinho Verde 2010 Douro** ..... £7.00  
Made from the Arinto Grape this vinho verde is much broader and riper than usual, while still maintaining the classic vinho verde character
- 62**      **Dao Garrida Branco 2010 Aliança Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £6.50  
Delicious pale yellow fruity white. Good fresh acidity makes for a refined and elegant wine with a long finish.
- 63**      **Tons De Dourum 2011 Upper Douro Ramos Franco** ..... £7.50  
From the Banks of the Upper Douro this 4-variety blend makes for a lovely smooth, creamy white, similar in style to a Rhone viognier.
- 64**      **Santa Ana Reisling 2010 QDSA Vinhos Lisbon** ..... £10.00  
From the outskirts of Lisbon this pioneering Englishman is making outstanding dry Reisling for the first time. A real rival to any southern hemisphere dry Reisling. My favourite grape at this time of year.

## Red Wines

- 167**      **Dao Reserva 2009 Aliança Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £6.25  
Lovely soft fruity red, medium bodied with a hint of pine and vanilla. Well balanced acidity and excellent value for money for a Reserve wine
- 67**      **Foral Reserva 2007 Aliança Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £6.50  
Well balanced with soft fruits and jam. Perfect with poultry. A lovely full flavoured but delicate red

- 68** **Quinta da Garrida Dao Reserva Red 2008 Alianca Vinhos de Portugal "2012 Gold Medal wine awards"** ..... £7.00  
Deep ruby colour, light and floral, fruity but full bodied with an exhuberant nose. Aged in oak to give a toastiness trademark Dao texture.
- 69** **Aragones 2009 Joao Portugal Ramos Alenteijo** ..... £7.50  
One of Southern Portugal's leading wine makers. Outstanding single varietal red, soft, smooth, fruity and so moorish.
- 71** **Ribamar 2006 Reserva Particular Tinto Paulo de Silva** ..... £9.00  
The reserve Cuvée from this tiny producer in the Sintra area. A robust red and only from the best vines does the Ribamar get selected.
- 72** **Quinta das Baceladas 2006 Alianca Vinhos Douro** ..... £10.00  
Big ripe fruit and ruby colour from this Decanter magazine recommended red. Balanced fruit and tannins make this outstanding value.
- 74** **Quinta Rigodeira Reserva 2005 Alianca Vinhos Douro** ..... £10.00  
Lovely mature Red with soft oak tannins and gentle fruit acidity. A really lovely Red for the Sunday Roast
- 76** **Quinta dos Quatro Ventos 2008 Alianca Vinhos de Portugal** ..... £10.00  
Aged in new French oak to give a silky texture with well balanced tannins. A full bodied rich and fruity top drawer red
- 77** **Quinta Dos Quatro Ventos Reserva Single Estate 2006 Alianca Vinhos Douro** ..... £30.00  
Dark fruits and chocolate. Intense inky colour with real length. A huge red !!!!! From this Boutique vineyard a must try!
- 80** **Quinta dos Quatro Ventos 2007 Alianca Vinhos de Portugal Magnum - 2 bottles** ..... £22.00  
Aged in new French oak to give a silky texture with well balanced tannins. A full bodied rich and fruity top drawer red
